The MAIA Master is a two-year programme of study divided into four semesters designed and developed to ensure a clear and structured educational progress in the field of medical image analysis, fully integrated among the three universities of the consortium:

The overall objective is to start from science fundamentals, low-level image and signal processing and acquisition. The second semester is devoted to more advanced image processing algorithms along with machine learning and pattern recognition. Special emphasis will be given to fundamentals of medical robotics and algorithm optimization methods. The third semester will take advantage of the previous modules and will focus on developing frameworks of computer aided detection and diagnosis systems with special emphasis to its clinical applicability and evaluation. In addition, advanced medical robotics will be covered taking into account computer aided surgery and assisted intervention. In addition a project on medical imaging will be proposed which will put those topics into practice. The final semester will be fully devoted to the development of the master thesis in a topic proposed by the consortium, collaborating companies/research labs or by the motivation of the student within the context of medical image analysis.

An induction week is organized each year in September during which the enrolled students are informed about the programme, the assessment and the rules. The induction week also permits new students to meet second-year students or former MAIA students.

Academic structure of the masters and mobility:

The two-year study programme proposed is divided into four semesters. The first three semesters are taught, while the last semester corresponds to the Masters thesis. The Masters is kicked off by an induction week in September, held in Le Creusot, France. **The first semester, S1 (6 months)**, is carried out within the Centre Universitaire Condorcet in Le Creusot, a subdivision of the department of Sciences and Technology of the University of Burgundy, France. **The second semester, S2 (6months)**, takes place in the Università degli studi di Cassino e del Lazio Meridionale, in Cassino, Italy. **The third semester, S3 (6 months)**, is hosted by the Escola Politècnica Superior of the Universitat de Girona, in Catalunya, Spain. **The fourth semester, S4 (6 months)**, the Masters thesis consists in either an introduction to research carried out in one of the laboratories of the consortium or an industry placement in a company involved in imaging or robotics medical technologies. The majority of students are expected to carry out their thesis within one of the consortium universities' lab. However, they can also choose to join another host laboratory/company for their thesis which will need to be accredited by the International MSc Academic Board (IMAB), the steering committee for all academic aspects, according to Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees regulations.

Estructura académica del máster y de la movilidad:

El programa de estudio de dos años propuesto se divide en cuatro semestres. Los tres primeros semestres se imparten, mientras que el último semestre corresponde a la tesis de máster. El Master se inicia con una semana de inducción en septiembre, celebrada en Le Creusot, Francia. El primer semestre, S1 (6 meses), se lleva a cabo en el Centro Universitario Condorcet en Le Creusot, una subdivisión del Departamento de Ciencias y Tecnología de la Universidad de Borgoña, Francia. El segundo semestre, S2 (6 meses), se lleva a cabo en la Università degli Studi di Cassino e del Lazio Meridionale, en Cassino, Italia. El tercer semestre, S3 (6 meses), es organizado por la Escuela Politécnica Superior de la Universidad de Girona, en Cataluña, España. El cuarto semestre, S4 (6 meses), la tesis de máster consiste en ya sea una introducción a la investigación llevada a cabo en uno de los laboratorios del consorcio o una inserción en la industria en una empresa dedicada a tecnologías de robótica o imagen médica. Se espera que la mayoría de los estudiantes para llevar a cabo su tesis dentro de un laboratorio de una de las universidades del consorcio. Sin embargo, también pueden optar por unirse a otro laboratorio / empresa para su tesis en cualquier país de la Unión Europea, que tendrá que ser acreditada por el Consejo Académico y Administrativo del máster (AAB), el comité de dirección de todos los aspectos académicos.

Bank account information

Dear student,

University of Girona, coordinating institution of MAIA, is in charge of periodically transferring you the scholarship instalments. In order to be able do that, we will **open for you an account in a Spanish bank** called Abanca: <u>https://www.abanca.com/es</u> (the website is only in Spanish and Galician, but they have a Mobile App in English). Since UdG is based in Spain, it is very convenient to have a Spanish bank account, because it considerably simplifies the procedure of transferring money.

Besides, we have an agreement with Abanca that is difficult to have with any other bank in Spain. This agreement includes: (1) the possibility of opening bank accounts for you although you are not physically present and you do not provide original documentation; (2) having an account with especial conditions. Some important conditions of this bank account are:

- Opening and maintenance without commission
- Debit card without issue costs
- Money withdrawal from an ATM worldwide without commission up to 5 times per month. In Spain, only without commission if you use Bankia, Sabadell and "Euro6000" ATMs
- SEPA transfers (mainly within Europe and in Euros) through online banking or mobile app without commission

To have these conditions the account holder must be under 30.

The procedure for opening these accounts is the following:

- UdG will open the accounts during summer
- We'll bring all the bank documents to the Induction Week in Le Creusot (ID20.... Sept 12-15, 20....)
- You will sign the documentation
- We'll give you copy of the documentation, debit card and passwords
- We'll send all the signed documents to the bank

Important: if you have ever been resident in Spain before, please inform us now. If you have never been resident in Spain, you do not need to inform us.







All this procedure must be completed during Induction Week, because we need all bank accounts ready to proceed with the first payment at mid/end September. Please note that you <u>need to foresee a lump</u> <u>sum for first September payments</u> (housing, insurance, food awaiting effective payment of grants after university registrations during the induction days).

Therefore, I use the opportunity to ask you to please try to arrive on time for the Induction week in Le Creusot. Confirmation of arrival is also required to unblock EU funds at UdG department and always takes some time. If you are not able to be there please inform us as soon as possible.

To begin the process of opening the bank account the first step would be to return signed the document that I will email you at beginning of July: *declaration of tax residence*. You must return it signed in both pages by email **before the deadline set in the email.**

If you already have an European bank account it is not necessary to open a Spanish account. Please contact us in this case.
